YOUth INSPIRE run a 13-Week Youth Employability Programme - Licence to Work specifically designed for young people aged 18-24 years old. We collaborate with local businesses and community organisations to support our Rangatahi into the world of work.

After leaving school Carl found it hard to get employment and lost all motivation. Carl completed the **Licence to Work** programme and was employed by Downers where he did his work experience.


